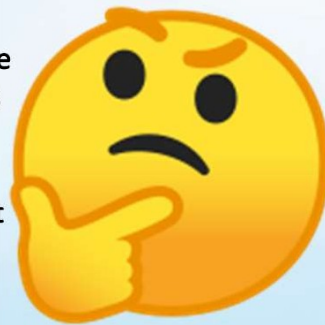

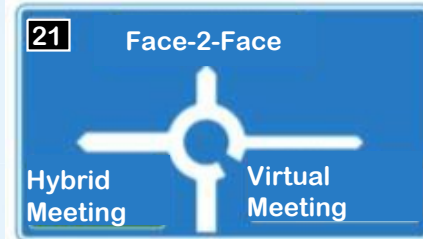
Which Direction Now?
